



Rapid Recall Facts

Year 1 – Term 2

I know doubles of numbers to 10.

By the end of this term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts **instantly**.

$$0 + 0 = 0$$

$$1 + 1 = 2$$

$$2 + 2 = 4$$

$$3 + 3 = 6$$

$$4 + 4 = 8$$

$$5 + 5 = 10$$

$$6 + 6 = 12$$

$$7 + 7 = 14$$

$$8 + 8 = 16$$

$$9 + 9 = 18$$

$$10 + 10 = 20$$

Top Tips

The secret to success is practising **little** and **often**. Use time wisely. Can you practise these Rapid Recall Facts while walking to school or during a car journey? You don't need to practise them all at once: perhaps you could have a fact of the day. If you would like more ideas, please speak to your child's teacher.

Ping Pong – In this game, the parent says "Ping" and the child replies "Pong". Then the parent says a number and the child doubles it. For a harder version, the adult can say "Pong." The child replies "Ping" and then halves the next number given.
