Attendance, Uniform & Labels

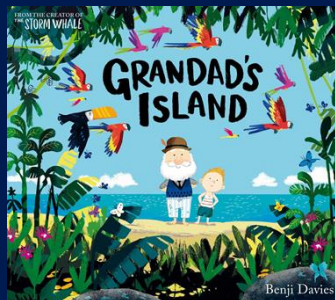
- Please try wherever possible to book routine medical and dental appointments out of school hours or during school holidays.

English

Spellings and Phonics

- Children will learn Year 1 High Frequency Words.
- Children will receive HFWs each week on the website.
- Practice them at home.
- Children will be asked informally to spell the HFWs they have been given.
- We will be following ELS phonics.
- Letter with Oxford Owl login details.
- Phonics screening will take place in Term 5-more information to follow.
- Phonics workshop with Mrs Morrison.

Reading



- The children will have 3 books on a Monday, these will be two decodable and one shared book.
- Please read with your child, encouraging use of phonics and discuss the text thoroughly.
- If they complete all 3 books, re-read them. This helps to build fluency and understanding of the text.
- Reading at home 3 or more times during the week will be rewarded with a sticker.
- Please only record school books in the reading record.



Maths

We follow the White Rose maths scheme. We do lots of practical activities alongside the workbooks to allow the children to build a solid understanding of different concepts.

This term we will focus on Place Value.

Other areas of learning during the year:

- Addition and subtraction
- Measurement and telling the time
- Times tables 2, 5, 10
- Correct number formation
- Spelling 1-20



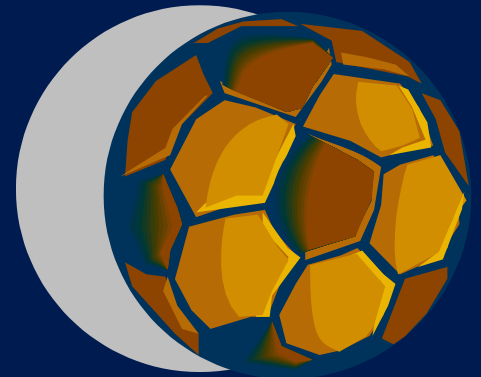


P.E.

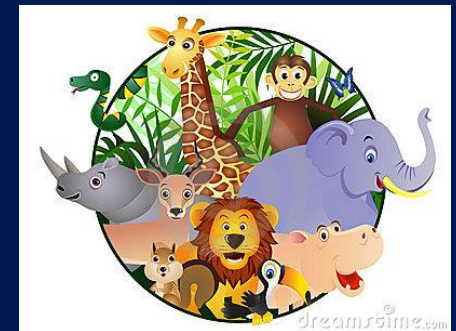
